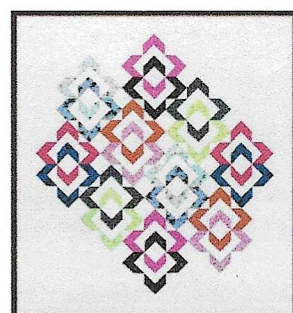
On **February 6** Carol Vogel will teach you a **Reversible Flip and Sew Table Runner**. You may remember this Table runner from Carol's Trunk Show.
